PEDDLER INFORMATION

Licenses and Permits

INTRODUCTION:

A Peddler is defined as:

Peddler is any person traveling by foot or vehicle, from place to place, offering goods for sale. (E.g. Person selling flowers from door to door, and having no fixed sales location.)

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS:

As of November 30, 2011, Peddlers in Martin County are no longer required to obtain a Peddler Identification Card from the Growth Management Department. The identification card requirement was dropped pursuant to adoption of Ordinance #901. There is no application to fill out from the Growth Management Department.

The Tax Collector's Office defines a Peddler as operating a home based business. Any person wishing to operate as a Peddler within Martin County must register with, and obtain a "business tax receipt" from, the Martin County Tax Collector.

TAX COLLECTOR'S OFFICE:

A Home Based Business Tax Receipt affidavit is obtained and processed at the Martin County Tax Collector. Phone: 288-5595. An annual fee of \$26.25 will be collected by them and they will issue your Business Tax Receipt.
