Demonstrates Commitment to Safety: Maintains focus during task completion and avoids distractions. Exercises caution when performing tasks requiring high concentration. Exemplifies safe behavior and encourages others to work safely.

Maintaining Cleanliness and Order: Keeps the workspace clean and free of clutter. Ensures walkways are clear of obstacles, debris, spills, water, grease, oil, and other hazards. Maintains and stores materials, inventory, tools, and equipment properly to avoid hazards and prevent injuries.

Safety Techniques and Practices: Employs proper lifting techniques to prevent back injuries and avoid injury from twisting while lifting. Adopts ergonomic practices in daily tasks to organize the work area for optimal posture and reduce repetitive movements. Alternates tasks efficiently to avoid repetitive injuries.

Lead by Example: A co-worker who acts as a mentor and guide to others. They demonstrate a safety-focused approach, encouraging others to adopt and maintain safe behaviors and practices in the workplace.
