Local Actions

- Cleveland Clinic Martin Health continues drive thru testing (by appointment only) for those that meet FDOH criteria. For an appointment, call 772-419-3360. More information is at: www.martinhealth.org
- The Martin County BoCC has voted to allow golf courses to remain open provided they restrict access and follow social distancing.
- Park facilities and amenities update:
 - Use of trails, pathways, boardwalks, fishing piers and open areas is permitted.
 - All programs, amenities, facilities and athletic complexes are closed, including the use of water fountains. Phipps Park Campground will remain open and will not accept any new reservations.
 - Martin County-owned boat ramps will be open for recreational boating activities on weekdays and be closed on weekends only; Sandsprit Park and the Jensen Beach Boat Ramp will be open to commercial marine activity
- Martin County has launched the www.martin.fl.us/covid19dashboard to provide county specific data; dashboard access updated.



Tests Reported



CDC Recommendations
