Local Actions

- No open burning is permitted due to the dry conditions.
- Martin County BoCC special meeting to discuss COVID-19 related issues on April 9 at 9AM
- Martin County has launched the www.martin.fl.us/covid19dashboard to provide county specific data.
- Martin County playgrounds, tennis, pickleball and basketball courts, park restroom facilities and athletic fields for organized and pickup are closed.
- Martin County-owned boat ramps will be open for recreational boating activities on weekdays and be closed on weekends only; Sandspirt Park and the Jensen Beach Boat Ramp north of Indian RiverSide Park will be open to commercial marine activity

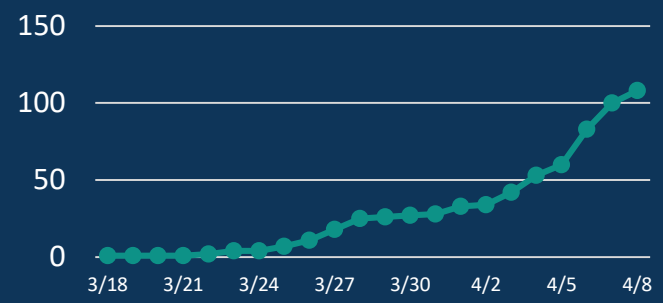

Tests Reported

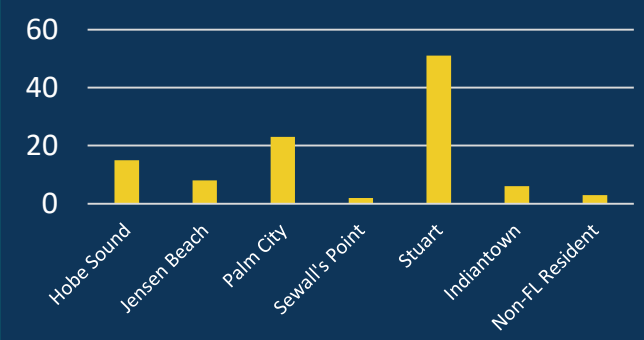
Reflects tests conducted by FDOH or returned to FDOH Martin from private labs.

CDC Recommendations
