



**Brightline Construction Advisory
Lane Closure and Work Zone Updates for Orlando Extension
(Phase 2 - South Florida to Orlando)**

ORLANDO, FL. (August 8, 2021) – Brightline announces lane closures, work zone, railroad crossing and bridge work information for Phase 2 construction from Orlando to West Palm Beach, connecting Orlando to South Florida. Motorists and watercraft should proceed with extra caution through work zones and adhere to posted detour signs, speed limits and other signage. **Full closures and high-profile closures are indicated in red.** Railroad construction information can also be found online at <https://www.gobrightline.com/railroad-construction>.

Orange County

Orlando International Airport

Eastbound and westbound Cargo Rd. between Bear Rd. and Casa Verde Rd. (north of Orlando International Airport)

Extended single lane closure in each direction through Fall 2021 for bridge work. One lane will remain open in each direction.

Beachline Expressway/SR 528

Eastbound Beachline Expressway/SR 528 between Narcoossee Rd. and SR 417 (milepost 13-15)

Continuous day-time shoulder closure, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Eastbound Beachline Expressway/SR 528 between SR 417 and Innovation Way (milepost 16-18)

Continuous day-time shoulder closure, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Eastbound Beachline Expressway/SR 528 between Dallas Blvd. and SR 520 (milepost 27-28)

(Exit 12), travel south on Goldenrod Rd. to cross over SR 528 and turn left to access eastbound Beachline Expressway/SR 528.

(Exit 208), travel east on Port St. John Pkwy. to Grissom Pkwy, travel south on Grissom Pkwy. to Canaveral Groves Blvd., travel west on Canaveral Groves Blvd. to Hartville Ave., travel south on Hartville Ave. to Citrus Blvd. and travel west on Citrus Blvd. to access Pine St.
- Southbound Pine St. traffic wishing to travel south of the SR 528 overpass will be directed to travel north on Pine St. to Citrus Blvd., travel east on Citrus Blvd. to Hartville Ave., travel north on Hartville Ave. to Canaveral Groves Blvd., travel east on Canaveral Groves Blvd. to Grissom Pkwy., travel north on Grissom Pkwy. to Port St. John Pkwy., travel west on Port St. John Pkwy. to I-95, travel south on I-95 to SR 524 (Exit 202), travel west on SR 524 to Adamson Rd., travel north on Adamson Rd. to Coconut Ave. and travel west on Coconut Ave. to access Pine St.

Full road closure through June 2022 for bridge work at Crane Creek.

Detour Information:

- Eastbound E. Melbourne Ave. traffic will be directed to travel north on E. Melbourne Ct., to E. New Haven Ave., travel east on E. New Haven Ave. to Front St and travel south on Front St. to access E. Melbourne Ave.
- Westbound E. Melbourne Ave traffic will be directed to travel north on Front St. to E. New Haven Ave., travel west on E. New Haven Ave. to E. Melbourne Ct. and travel south on E. Melbourne Ct. to access E. Melbourne Ave.

Melbourne – Railroad Crossing at Prospect Ave. (LONGTERM CLOSURE)

Full road closure through May 2022 for bridge work at Crane Creek. *Crossing will be fully closed until completion of work.*

Detour Information:

- Eastbound Prospect Ave. traffic will be directed to Stone St., travel south on Stone St. to WH Jackson St., travel east on WH Jackson St. to US-1 and travel north on US-1 to access Prospect Ave.

- Westbound Prospect Ave. traffic will be directed to US-1, travel south on US-1 to WH Jackson St., travel west on WH Jackson St. to Stone St. and travel north on Stone St. to access Prospect Ave.

Bridges

Melbourne – Eau Gallie River

Day-time bridge work operations, including pile driving, Monday through Sunday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., continuing through Q3 2022 to install temporary work trestle (platforms) for cranes on the west side of the existing active railroad bridge (southwest bank) and for bridge construction.

Melbourne – Crane Creek

Day-time bridge work operations, including pile driving, Monday through Sunday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., continuing through Q2 2022 to construct a railroad bridge on the east side of the existing bridge.

Palm Bay – Turkey Creek

Day-time bridge work operations, including pile driving, Monday through Sunday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., continuing through Q3 2022 to install a temporary work trestle (platforms) for cranes on the east side of the existing active railroad bridge (northeast bank) and for bridge construction.

Malabar / Grant-Valkaria – Goat Creek

Day-time bridge work operations, including pile driving, Monday through Saturday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., continuing through 2021 to construct a railroad bridge on the east side of the new bridge.

Day-time pile driving operations and demolition work, Monday through Sunday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., continuing through 2022 to construct a railroad bridge on the west side of the existing bridge (south bank).

Day-time flagging operations, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., for rail work. *Crossings may be closed briefly (1-2 minutes) as trucks enter and exit Savannah Rd.*

Martin County

Jensen Beach – NE Jensen Beach Blvd.

Day-time flagging operations, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. for rail work. *Crossings may be closed briefly (1-2 minutes) as trucks enter and exit NE Jensen Beach Blvd.*

Jensen Beach – NE Dixie Hwy.

Day-time flagging operations, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. for rail work. *Crossings may be closed briefly (1-2 minutes) as trucks enter and exit NE Dixie Hwy.*

Stuart – NW Alice St.

Day-time flagging operations, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. for rail work. *Crossings may be closed briefly (1-2 minutes) as trucks enter and exit NW Alice St.*

Stuart – NW Fern St.

Day-time flagging operations, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. for rail work. *Crossings may be closed briefly (1-2 minutes) as trucks enter and exit NW Fern St.*

Stuart – Railroad Crossing at SE Dixie Hwy.

Full road closure, until 6 p.m., Saturday, August 14.

- Southbound traffic will be detoured to travel west on West on SE Cove Rd. to SE Federal Hwy., travel south on SE Federal Hwy. to SE Heritage Blvd. and travel east on SE Heritage Blvd. to access Dixie Hwy.
- Northbound traffic will be detoured to travel west on SE Heritage Blvd. to SE Federal Hwy., travel north on SE Federal Hwy. to SE Cove Rd. and travel east on SE Cove Rd. to access A1A/Dixie Hwy.

Stuart – Southbound A1A from south of SE Cove Rd. to south of SE Alicia St.

Continuous shoulder closure through June 2021.

Port Salerno – Railroad Crossing at SE Broward St.

Full road closure, 6 a.m., Sunday, August 8 to 5 p.m., Tuesday, August 17.

- Eastbound traffic will be detoured on to Front Ave until reaching Ebbtide Ave to turn North, East on Salerno Rd, and back South on Dixie Hwy.
- Westbound traffic will be detoured to travel north on Dixie Hwy./ A1A to SE Salerno Rd., travel west on SE Salerno Rd. to SE Ebbtide Ave. and travel south on SE Ebbtide Ave. to access SE Broward St.

Hobe Sound – Railroad Crossing at SE Osprey St.

Full road closure, 7 a.m., Tuesday, August 17 to 6 p.m., August 27.

- Eastbound traffic will be directed to travel south on Dixie Hwy. to Crossrip St., travel east on Crossrip St. to Gomez Ave. and travel north on Gomez Ave. to access SE Osprey St.

- Westbound traffic will be directed to travel south on Gomez Ave. to Crossrip St., travel west on Crossrip St. to Dixie Hwy. and travel north on Dixie Hwy. to access SE Osprey St.

Hobe Sound – Railroad Crossing at SE Pettway St.

Full road closure until 6 p.m., Monday, August 9.

Detour Information:

- Eastbound SE Pettway St. traffic will be directed to travel north on Dixie Hwy. to SE Crossrip St., travel east on Crossrip St. to SE Gomez Ave. and travel south on SE Gomez Ave. to access SE Pettway St.
- Westbound SE Pettway St. traffic will be directed to travel north on SE Gomez Ave. to SE Crossrip St., travel west on SE Crossrip St. to Dixie Hwy. and travel south on Dixie Hwy. to access SE Pettway St.
- Southbound and Northbound traffic between Dixie Hwy. and SE Gomez Ave. using SE Pettway St. as a thru way are advised to proceed south to use SE Bridge Rd. as a thru way.

Bridges

Stuart – Rio Waterway

Day-time bridge work operations and pile driving operations, Monday to Saturday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., continuing through Q3 2021 to install temporary work trestles (platforms) for cranes as well as demolition and construction of railroad bridge on the west side of the existing active railroad bridge (southwest bank).

Port Salerno – Salerno Waterway North

Day-time bridge work operations, including crane mobilization, demolition and pile driving, Monday to Saturday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., continuing through Q3 2021.

Port Salerno – Manatee Waterway South

Day-time bridge work operations, including crane mobilization, demolition and pile driving, Monday to Saturday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., continuing through Q4 2021.

Palm Beach County

Railroad Crossings / Lane Closures.

Jupiter – Riverside Dr. and Alternate A1A

Day-time flagging operations, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. to move materials for bridge construction, continuing through Summer 2021. *Crossings may be closed briefly (1-2 minutes) as trucks enter and exit the right of way.*

Bridges

Jupiter – Loxahatchee River

Day-time pile driving operations, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday through Sunday, continuing through October 2021 to install temporary work trestles (platforms) for cranes on the east and west sides of the existing bridge (north bank).

Jupiter - Loxahatchee River

Day-time pile driving operations on the bascule span, drawbridge. Work will require bridge to remain in the down position during the following dates and times:

- 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday, August 9.

Backup dates of August 5, 6, 10 and 11 may be utilized if necessary. The bridge will operate on its normal schedule outside of workdays and times.
