



Brightline Construction Advisory
Lane Closure and Work Zone Updates for Orlando Extension
(Phase 2 - South Florida to Orlando)

ORLANDO, FL. (August 30, 2021) – Brightline announces lane closures, work zone, railroad crossing and bridge work information for Phase 2 construction from Orlando to West Palm Beach, connecting Orlando to South Florida. Motorists and watercraft should proceed with extra caution through work zones and adhere to posted detour signs, speed limits and other signage. **Full closures and high-profile closures are indicated in red.** Railroad construction information can also be found online at <https://www.gobrightline.com/railroad-construction>.

Orange County

Orlando International Airport

Eastbound and westbound Cargo Rd. between Bear Rd. and Casa Verde Rd. (north of Orlando International Airport)

Extended single lane closure in each direction through Fall 2021 for bridge work. One lane will remain open in each direction.

Northbound Jeff Fuqua Blvd. from north of Orlando International Airport to Cargo Rd.

Night-time, single lane closure, 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Wednesday, September 1 to Friday, September 3 for paving.

Beachline Expressway/SR 528

Extended single lane closure on exit ramp through 2021 for bridge work.

 - Option 2: Eastbound Seminole Ave. will be directed to travel south on Waverly Pl. to E. Fee Ave., travel east on E. Fee Ave. to US-1 and travel north on US-1 to access E. Seminole Ave.
- **Westbound E. Seminole Ave.:**
 - Southbound US-1 traffic wishing to travel west on E. Seminole Ave. will be directed to travel south on US-1 to E. Fee Ave., travel west on E. Fee Ave. to Waverly Pl. and travel north on Waverly Pl. to E. Seminole Ave. coming from SB US-1 will be directed to travel west on Fee Ave. to Waverly Pl. and travel north on Waverly Pl. to E. Seminole Ave.
 - Northbound US-1 traffic wishing to travel west on E. Seminole Ave. will be directed to continue north on US-1 to Silver Palm Ave., travel west on Silver Palm Ave. to Waverly Pl. and travel south on Waverly Pl. to E. Seminole Ave.

Melbourne – Railroad Crossing at New Haven Ave.

Full road closure, 7 a.m., Saturday, September 11 to 7 p.m. Saturday, September 25.

Detour Information

- Eastbound New Haven Ave. traffic will be directed to travel north on Waverly Pl. to Strawbridge Ave., travel east on Strawbridge Ave. to US-1 and travel south on US-1 to New Haven Ave.
- Westbound New Haven Ave. traffic will be directed to travel north on US-1 to Strawbridge Ave., travel west on Strawbridge Ave. to Waverly Pl. and travel south on Waverly Pl. to New Haven Ave.

Melbourne – E. Melbourne Ave. under railroad bridge (LONGTERM CLOSURE)

Full road closure through June 2022 for bridge work at Crane Creek.

Detour Information:

- Eastbound E. Melbourne Ave. traffic will be directed to travel north on Waverly Pl., to Strawbridge Ave., travel east on Strawbridge Ave. to US-1, travel south on US-1 to New Haven Ave., travel east on New Haven Ave. to Front St, and travel south on Front St. to access E. Melbourne Ave.
- Westbound E. Melbourne Ave traffic will be directed to travel north on Front St. to E. New Haven Ave., travel west on E. New Haven Ave. to US-1, travel north on US-1 to Strawbridge Ave., travel west on Strawbridge Ave to Waverly Pl. and travel south on Waverly Pl. to access E. Melbourne Ave.

Melbourne – Railroad Crossing at Prospect Ave. (LONGTERM CLOSURE)

Full road closure through May 2022 for bridge work at Crane Creek. *Crossing will be fully closed until completion of work.*

Detour Information:

- Eastbound Prospect Ave. traffic will be directed to Stone St., travel south on Stone St. to WH Jackson St., travel east on WH Jackson St. to US-1 and travel north on US-1 to access Prospect Ave.
- Westbound Prospect Ave. traffic will be directed to US-1, travel south on US-1 to WH Jackson St., travel west on WH Jackson St. to Stone St. and travel north on Stone St. to access Prospect Ave.

Indian River County – Railroad Crossing at Hawks Nest Rd.

Full road closure, 7 a.m., Monday September 13 to 7 p.m. Friday, September 17.

Private Road. No impact to traffic.

Bridges

Melbourne – Eau Gallie River

Day-time bridge work operations, including pile driving, Monday through Sunday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., continuing through Q3 2022 to install temporary work trestle (platforms) for cranes on the west side of the existing active railroad bridge (southwest bank) and for bridge construction.

Melbourne – Crane Creek

Day-time bridge work operations, Monday through Sunday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., continuing through Q2 2022 to construct a railroad bridge on the east side of the existing bridge. Intermittent pile driving will continue through September 2021 on the north side of Crane Creek near Melbourne Ave.

Palm Bay – Turkey Creek

Day-time bridge work operations, including pile driving, Monday through Sunday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., continuing through Q3 2022 to install a temporary work trestle (platforms) for cranes on the east side of the existing active railroad bridge (northeast bank) and for bridge construction.

Malabar / Grant-Valkaria – Goat Creek

Day-time bridge work operations, including pile driving, Monday through Saturday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., continuing through 2021 to construct a railroad bridge on the east side of the new bridge.

Palm Beach County

Day-time flagging operations, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. to move materials for bridge construction, continuing through Summer 2021. *Crossings may be closed briefly (1-2 minutes) as trucks enter and exit the right of way.*

Bridges

Jupiter – Loxahatchee River

Day-time pile driving operations, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday through Sunday, continuing through October 2021 to install temporary work trestles (platforms) for cranes on the east and west sides of the existing bridge (north bank).
